Meeting communique

Tuesday, 26 May 2026

The first official meeting of the fourth Multicultural Queensland Advisory Council (the Council) was held on 26 May 2026 in Brisbane.

The Minister for Women and Women's Economic Security, Minister for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships and Minister for Multiculturalism the Honourable Fiona Simpson MP opened the meeting by affirming the Council's role to advise on matters relating to culturally and linguistically diverse communities.

Council members discussed social cohesion and economic participation, including presentations from the Department of Trade, Employment and Training and the Department of Customer Services, Open Data and Small and Family Business.

Members also raised current and emerging issues, including the ongoing impact of global conflicts and humanitarian crises.
